2019 Highlights

Re-opening Ceremony

The campus accorded a rousing reception to the students by decorating the whole school with appealing quotes & presenting a welcoming

assembly especially to the new entrants. The entrants were gifted pens and flowers. The whole atmosphere was solemn and filled with the hymns from three different religions sung by the school Bhajan Group.

Environment day

Re – opening day was also observed as a day to celebrate Environment Day.

In the special morning assembly 12th grade students presented a thought provoking speech on 'Environment Pollution & How to save mother Earth'. They also donated some medicinal plants to our Principal.

Academic Achievements

Each year the school, holds the Annual prize distribution to honour those students who have made the school proud with their brilliant efforts in the academic field .

Class X result was 100% making us elated for their achievement. The students passed in flying colours with 21 students getting 90% and above, 37 students got distinction and 27 passing with first division. FAIZA HAJIRA got Full A+ . Ananya Jayaprasad, Anusree C A and Agrima S Dev brought glory to the school as they got Cent percent in Social Science.

Class XII result was 100% and the students performed excellently well. Vaishnavi K Suresh topped in the Science stream and Gouri A S topped in the Commerce stream.

Creating English Atmosphere

A rich English Language learning environment has been created in the school by making English speaking compulsory in the campus. Our principal emphasises on this fact & always students are given awareness that better English would allow them to communicate with a wider range of people. To ensure that this is properly implemented, CE leaders are appointed in each class.

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Introduction of internal Exams

With high expectation, to bring academic prowess, our senior principal introduced internal exams. Weekly test 1 & 2, Semester End Examination 1 & 2 for all the classes. In addition to this, classes 10 & 12 have Revision Test, Pre Board 1 & 2.

Modification of Time Table

In a bid to promote creativity & logical thinking among students, zero period has been introduced in the time table. As per the aim, students are allowed to do activities & practise for all the events held in the school during this zero period. So the academic period won't be affected. This zero period is a part of the time table & started from day 1 of the re-opening.

Online Exam centre for TCS and NTA

With the profound initiation of our principal Dr. C G Geetha, our school was chosen as the online exam centre for TCS and NTA to conduct competitive exams in the All India level. This gives a big boost in the status of the school and a wide publicity.

Canteen
