The programme was a great success and helped the students to know more about books and its importance. Students really enjoyed the programme.



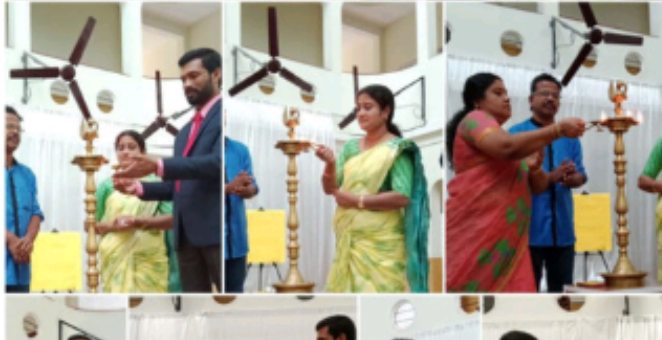
INTERNATIONAL YOGA AND WORLD MUSIC DAY

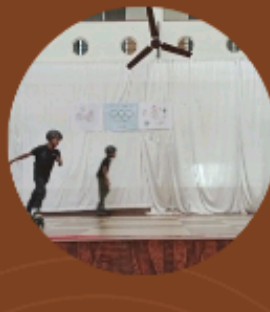

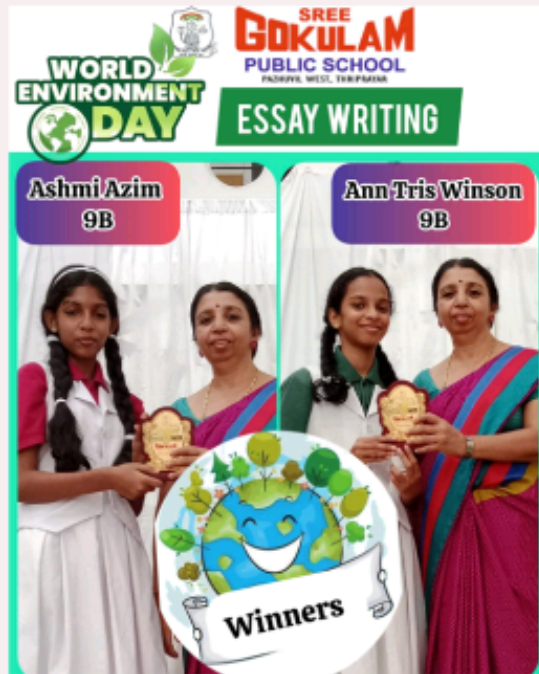
